### Summary

*Stable population*

*Stable age structure. Slight growth in numbers of working age.*

(NB: Bishopdale age structure figures not available for 2001 due to confidentiality.)

Households with children have declined slightly.

Moderate increase in outright ownership and private rented accommodation.  
(NB: Figures excludes Castle Bolton).

Strong growth in economically active population. This reflects growth in population and working age.

Distribution of employment is similar to National Park average, except for agriculture which is particularly strongly represented. (NB: Figures exclude Castle Bolton)

Occupation groups are very close to the National Park average. (NB Figures exclude Castle Bolton)

Lower than average proportion walk to work, but higher than the National Park average work mainly at home. High average distance to travel to work  
(NB Figures exclude Castle Bolton)

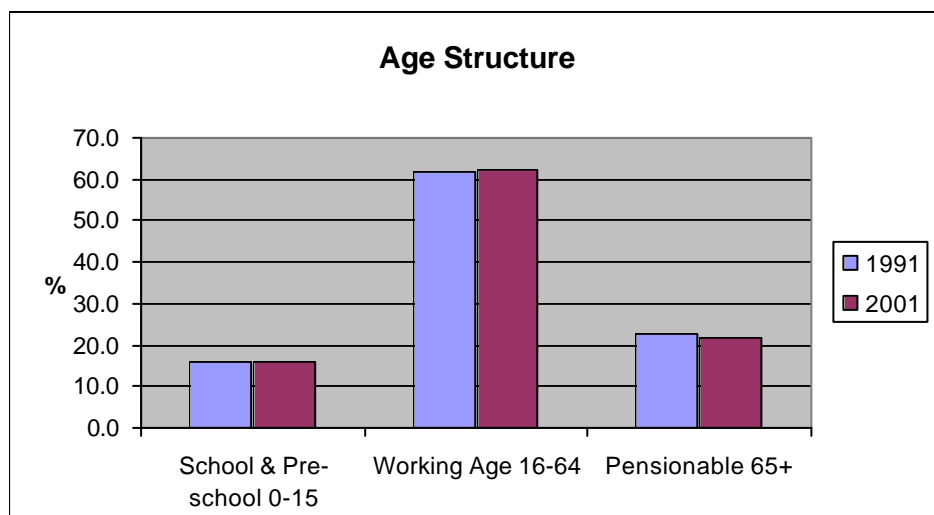
