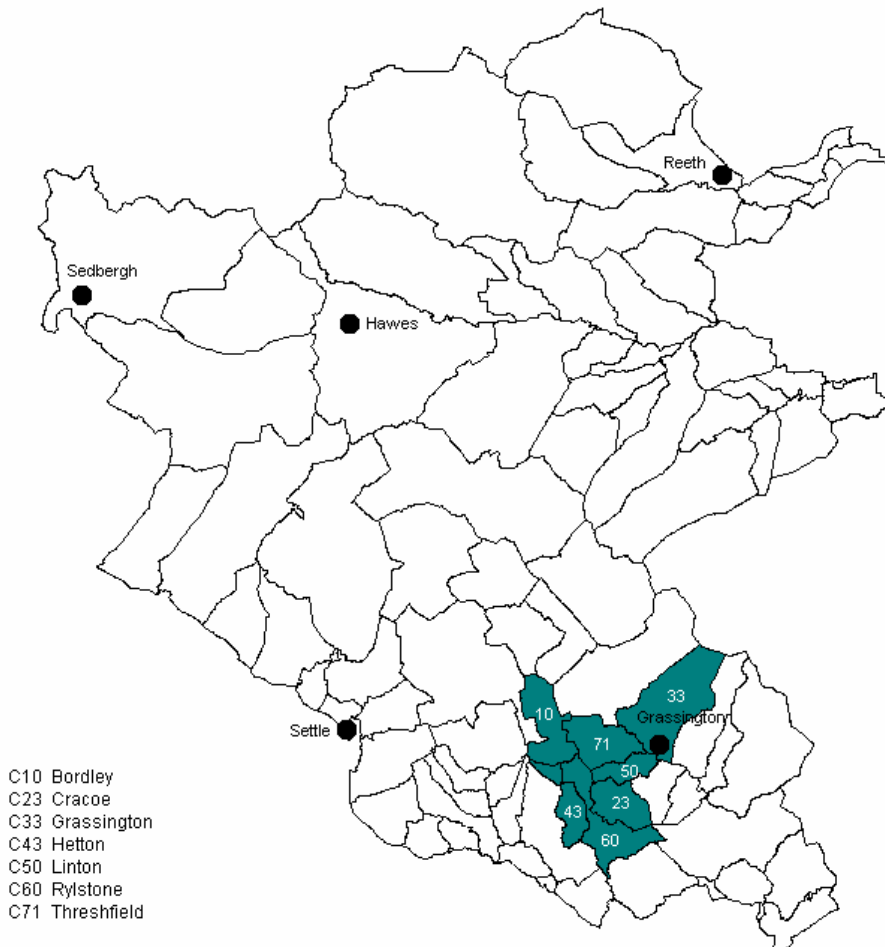




MID WHARFEDALE CENSUS PROFILE 1991-2001

Notes

1. Figures may not sum due to independent rounding and adjustments to preserve confidentiality.
2. Any parish that falls below the confidentiality threshold for Small Area Statistics data is merged with a contiguous parish. (Confidentiality threshold in 1991 was 50 persons/20 households, in 2001 the threshold was 100 persons/40 households.)
3. Where parishes are split by the National Park boundary and/or combined with others outside the boundary, an estimate has been made of the percentage in the Park.

Summary

Strong population growth

Most significant growth is in the number and proportion of pensioners.

Significant decline in household size. Significant increase in one person households

Significant decline in second home/holiday home ownership

Strong growth in outright ownership

Slight decline in mortgage ownership

Moderate growth in numbers economically active.

Employment dominated by services. Agricultural sector is low compared with Park average.

High representation by managers. Trades sector is under represented.

High level of car commuting. Low level of people working from home.

Significant increase in car population.

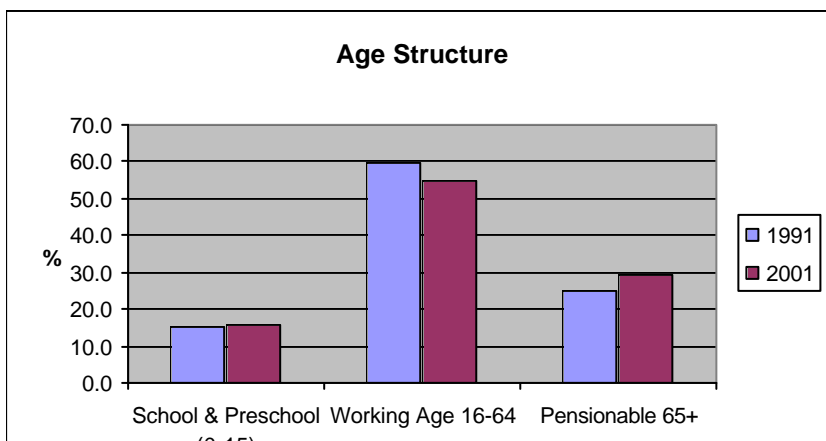
