



THREE PEAK PARISHES CENSUS PROFILE 1991-2001

(Parishes of Austwick, Clapham-cum-Newby, Horton in Ribblesdale, Ingleton, Thornton in Lonsdale)



Notes

1. Figures may not sum due to independent rounding and adjustments to preserve confidentiality.
2. Any parish that falls below the confidentiality threshold for Small Area Statistics data is merged with a contiguous parish. (Confidentiality threshold in 1991 was 50 persons/20 households, in 2001 the threshold was 100 persons/40 households.)
3. Where parishes are split by the National Park boundary and/or combined with others outside the boundary, an estimate has been made of the percentage in the Park.

Summary

Strong population growth

Growth in all three age sectors. Strongest amongst those of pensionable age.

Significant reduction in the number of second homes and holiday homes. Increase in outright ownership

Increase in the numbers economically active.

A wider distribution of employment than the National Park average.

High representation of process operatives

Low representation amongst the professions

Travel to work patterns similar to National Park distribution

Strong growth in car numbers

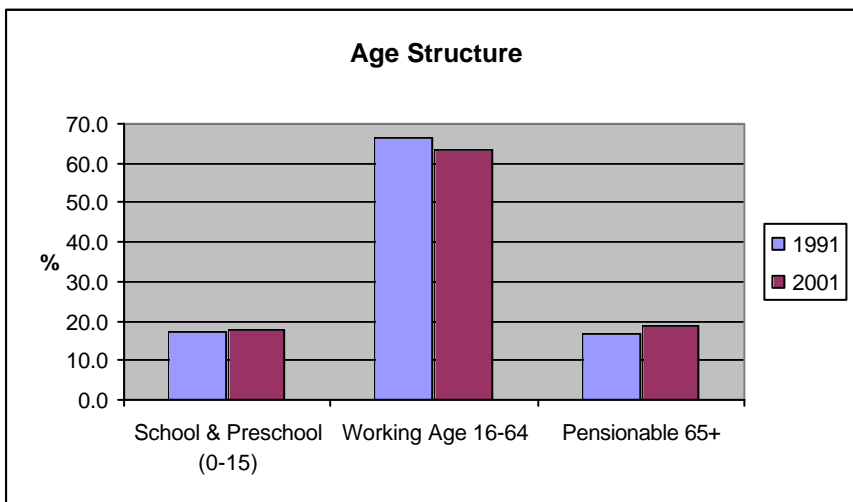
